Technology provides access to free legal advice

Central Highlands Community Legal Centre, with the generous support of the *Department of Justice & Regulation*, is now providing free legal information and advice to residents of Horsham and surrounds via video conferencing facilities. The program started this week and will commence as a six (6) month pilot program.

The use of video conferencing facilities means that people in the Wimmera can have the benefits of a face to face interview with a solicitor without having to travel to Ballarat or the outreach locations of Stawell and Ararat. Appointments will be weekly on a Monday afternoon from 2.00pm to 4.00pm.

All appointments are free and can cover a variety of topics including family law, family violence, credit and debt matters, infringements and neighbourhood disputes. The service is available by appointment only. To make an appointment, ring the Ballarat office on 5331 5999 to arrange a suitable time.
